17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ 7-2-102 – 7-2-105 are amended to read as*

12 (2) The following voting districts of Lonoke County as they
13 existed on January 1, 2011:

14 (A) Dortch voting district;

15 (B) England ward #1 voting district;

16 (C) England ward #2 voting district;

17 (D) England ward #3 voting district;

18 (E) England ward #4 voting district;

19 (F) Gray voting district;

20 (G) Gum Woods voting district;

21 (H) Keo City voting district;

22 (I) Lafayette voting district; and

23 (J) Pulaski voting district; and

16 existed on January 1, 2011:

18 (B) Banner B voting district;

19 (C) Dyer A voting district;

20 (D) Dyer B voting district;

22 (F) Haskell A voting district;

23 (G) Haskell B voting district;

24 (H) Holland voting district;

25 (I) Hurricane voting district;

26 (J) Jefferson voting district;

27 (K) Kentucky voting district;

28 (L) Liberty voting district;

29 (M) Marble voting district;

30 (N) Newcomb voting district;

31 (O) Shaw voting district;

32 (P) Smith voting district;

33 (Q) Traskwood voting district; and

34 (R) Union voting district.
