AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS REGARDING SALVAGE AUCTION BUYER'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAWS REGARDING SALVAGE
AUCTION BUYER'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-112-614(b)(2), regarding salvage auction buyer's identification cards, is amended to read as follows:
(2)(A) The department shall issue the salvage auction buyer's identification card at a fee not to exceed:
(A) Thirty five thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for the first card issued to the cardholder and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second card issued to the cardholder if the cardholder is:
(i) An Arkansas resident dealer or wrecker; and
(ii) At at least one (l) of the following:
(a)(i) A licensed new motor vehicle dealer;
(b)(ii) A licensed used motor vehicle dealer; or
(c)(iii) A licensed wrecker; or
(B) Three hundred fifty dollars (\$350) for the first card issued to the cardholder and two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the second eard issued to the cardholder if the cardholder is:
(i) An out-of-state resident; and
(ii) Licensed by another state as a motor vehicle dealer or wrecker and meets the requirements of the department.
