## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW A COUNTY TO ABOLISH THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE OF CONSTABLE IF APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE.


#### Abstract

Subtitle AMENDING THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW A COUNTY TO ABOLISH THE TOWNSHIP office of constable if approved by a vote OF THE PEOPLE.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Amendment 55 of the Arkansas Constitution, regarding powers of the quorum court, is amended to add a new subsection to read as follows:
(c)(1)(A) The Quorum Court may refer to the voters of the county, the issue of whether to abolish all township offices of constable in the county at a general election.
(B) The Quorum Court may refer the issue under subdivision (c)(l)(A) of this section upon approval by a majority of the members of the Quorum Court.
(2) If a majority of those voting on the question at a general election have approved the action to abolish all township offices of constable in the county, each township office of constable in the county shall be abolished at the end of the existing term for which the constable
was elected.
(3) The authority by the Quorum Court to call an election under (c)(1) of this section does not establish the position of constable as a county position.
