BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE

20

STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL

21

MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of

24

the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state

25

for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives

26

and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election

27

adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of

28

the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. Sections 1 and 2 of Amendment 42 of the Arkansas

31

Constitution are amended to read as follows:

§ 1. Commission created – Members – Powers.

33

There is hereby created a State Highway Commission which shall be

34

vested with all the powers and duties ~~now or hereafter imposed by law for the~~

35

~~administration of the State Highway Department, together with all powers~~

36

~~necessary or proper to enable the Commission or any of its officers or~~



1 ~~employees to carry out fully and effectively the regulations and laws~~
2 ~~relating to the State Highway Department~~ as may be prescribed by law.

4 § 2. Qualifications and appointment of members – Terms of office of
5 first commission.

6 Within ten days after the convening of the General Assembly of the
7 State of Arkansas in the year 1953, the Governor, by and with the advice and
8 consent of the Senate, shall appoint five persons who are qualified electors
9 of the State to constitute the State Highway Commission for terms of two,
10 four, six, eight and ten years respectively. The terms of the persons so
11 appointed shall be determined by lot. The Commissioners to be appointed from
12 the State at large; provided, however, that ~~no two Commissioners shall be~~
13 ~~appointed from any single Congressional District~~ at least one member shall be
14 appointed from each Congressional District.

15 In the event of rejection by the Senate of a person whose name has been
16 so submitted, the Governor shall within five days after receipt of written
17 notice from the Secretary of the Senate of such rejection submit the name of
18 another appointee to fill such vacancy. In the event the Governor should
19 within five days thereafter fail to appoint or fail to submit to the Senate
20 for confirmation the name of any person to be appointed, the Senate shall
21 proceed to make the appointment of its own choice.

22
23 SECTION 2. Section 6 of Amendment 42 of the Arkansas Constitution are
24 amended to read as follows:

25 § 6. Director of Highways.

26 The Commission shall appoint a Director of Highways who shall have such
27 duties as may be prescribed by ~~the Commission or by statute~~ law.

29 SECTION 3. This amendment shall become effective July 1, 2013.
