10 RESEARCH FOR THE SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY FOR
11 THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY
17 - LIGNITE RESEARCH APPROPRIATION FOR THE
18 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - LIGNITE RESEARCH. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from the
25 Southern Arkansas University Fund, for personal services and operating
26 expenses related to lignite research, including professional services,
27 supplies, purchase of equipment, construction expenses, and study and
28 sampling expenses of lignite research, of the Southern Arkansas University
29 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the sum of.....\$2,500,000.
30

31 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
33 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the passage and approval of this Act, the Chief
34 Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the
35 State Treasurer and the Auditor of State the sum of two million five hundred
36 thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the unobligated balance in the General



1 Improvement Fund to the Southern Arkansas University Fund to provide funds
2 for the purposes and appropriation provided in Section 1 of this Act.

3
4 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
13 with in disbursement of said funds.

14
15 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
27 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is
28 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this
29 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative
30 session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its
31 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper
32 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
33 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
34 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
35 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
