The Office of Attorney General shall on a quarterly basis provide to 3 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee a report of cash 4 funds received from court orders or settlement agreements. 14 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.
