32	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED I	NTO THE ARKANSAS	
33	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORAR	RY LAW.	
34	PRIORITIES. Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas		
35	considers the following items HIGH PRIORITY and within the r	cole and scope of	
36	the college:		

- 1 (1) The recruitment of underserved populations in the CCCUA service area,
- 2 including but not limited to: Latinos, African Americans, Aging, and Non-
- 3 Traditional students.
- 4 (2) The development and offering of viable programs as defined by the
- 5 Arkansas Department of Higher Education and the deletion of programs which
- 6 are not viable,
- 7 (3) The cultivating of relationships in the community that establishes more
- 8 industry training and promotes economic development within the CCCUA service
- 9 area,
- 10 (4) The continued development of working relationships with area K-12
- 11 institutions to provide concurrent enrollment, Advanced Placement, technical
- 12 training, and college readiness to these students,
- 13 (5) The development of a comprehensive change in the way the college prepares
- 14 students for college-level work, including the development of special mastery
- 15 learning programs within remedial math and English courses,
- 16 (6) The continued expansion of campus facilities to accommodate continued
- 17 record growth in credit and non-credit programs.
- 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 19 2011 2012 through June 30, 2012 2013.

- 21 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
- 27 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
- 28 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
- 29 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
- 30 with in disbursement of said funds.

- 32 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

Ţ	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
4	
5	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
7	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
