15 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY APPROPRIATION FOR
16 THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Office of Health Information Technology for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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7 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY -
 8 FEDERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the *Office of Health*
 9 *Information Technology*, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by
 10 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating
 11 expenses of the Office of Health Information Technology Federal Operations
 12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

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27 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY -
 28 HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 29 *Office of Health Information Technology*, to be payable from the Health
 30 Information Technology Fund, for personal services, state match, operating
 31 expenses and program matching grants by the Office of Health Information
 32 Technology for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

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6 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
8 TRANSFER PROVISION. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30 ~~2011~~
9 2012, any unexpended balance of funds remaining in the Miscellaneous Agencies
10 Fund Account for the DFA - Health Information Exchange Program shall be
11 transferred to the Health Information Technology Fund to provide state match
12 for the Federal - Health Information Technology Program.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
14 ~~2011~~ 2012 through June 30, ~~2012~~ 2013.

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16 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
