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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the National Park Community College for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

1 the National Park Community College for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the
 2 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known a
 3 ifo is "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
 4 purposes: four hundred-two (402) temporary or part-time employees, when
 5 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 6 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 7 appropriate classification.

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 9 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 10 to the National Park Community College, to be payable from the National Park
 11 Community College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 12 National Park Community College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the

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 28 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
 29 to the National Park Community College, to be payable from cash funds as
 30 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the National Park Community College, for
 31 personal services and operating expenses of the National Park Community
 32 College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

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15 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 21 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 22 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 23 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 24 with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.

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
