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9 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 11 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - UTILITIES DIVISION. In the event of unforeseen 12 conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in the Utilities Division appropriation of this 13 14 Act and such events make it necessary that the Public Service Commission -15 Utilities Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the 16 objectives of the agency, the Director of the Public Service Commission is 17 hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief 18 Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter provided, for transfer of the 19 additional appropriations provided in the Contingency appropriation to the 20 appropriations provided by the Utilities Division appropriation, but in no 21 event shall the transfers exceed the appropriations provided in the 22 Contingency appropriation of this Act. Whenever the Director of the Public 23 Service Commission deems it necessary to establish additional appropriations 24 as authorized herein, he or she shall file with the Governor a written report 25 accompanied by necessary supporting documents setting forth the facts, 26 justifications, and circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon 27 receipt of such reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his or her 28 designee, shall study the same, and if he or she shall determine that such 29 additional appropriations are being sought in strict compliance with this 30 Act, the Governor, after seeking prior review and prior approval by the 31 Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee, may approve or 32 modify such request for additional appropriations as in his or her judgment 33 he or she deems necessary, and shall forward a copy thereof to the Chief 34 Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon receipt thereof, the Chief Fiscal Officer 35 of the State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer upon his 36 books in accordance with the provisions as set out therein.

1 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 2 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 3 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 4 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 5 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 6 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. 20 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - TAX DIVISION. In the event additional 23 appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in 24 the Tax Division appropriation of this Act and specific cases, situations, 25 and/or programs make it necessary that the Arkansas Public Service Commission 26 - Tax Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives 27 of the Division, the Chairman of the Arkansas Public Service Commission is 28 hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief 29 Fiscal Officer of the State for transfers of the appropriations provided in 30 the Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act to 31 other line items within the Tax Division appropriation. In no event shall 32 the transfers in any fiscal year exceed the appropriations provided in the 33 Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act. The 34 Governor may approve or modify such request for transfer of appropriations as 35 in his or her judgment he or she deems necessary, and shall seek prior review 36 and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council and inform the Chief Fiscal

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Officer of the State. Upon notification, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer upon his or her
 books in accordance with the provisions as set out herein.

4 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 5 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 6 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 7 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 8 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 9 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 10 has determined that the Public Service Commission - Tax Division may operate 11 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Public Service Commission - Tax Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. 12 13 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 14 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 15 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of 16 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 17 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the 18 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a 19 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010 21 <u>2012</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2013</u>.

23 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 25 HIGH COST FUND. To ensure that telecommunications rates are reasonable and 26 affordable, the Arkansas Public Service Commission should take all reasonable 27 steps necessary to reduce the Arkansas High Cost Fund (AHCF), and avoid 28 mandating any additional charges or expenses for telecommunications services 29 that could increase AHCF assessments which would result in higher AHCF 30 surcharges to customers.

31

32 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 33 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 35 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 36 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 7 8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14

15 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 16 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 17 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of 18 19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 20 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm 21 22 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 23 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 24 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 25 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012. 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
