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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
24 for the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the 2012-2013 fiscal year,

35 and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate

36 classification.

 3 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable
 4 from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, for personal services of
 5 the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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 3 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - WILLIAM H. BOWEN SCHOOL OF LAW. There is
 4 hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be
 5 payable from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, from special
 6 revenues received from additional uniform filing fees in circuit court as
 7 authorized by Arkansas Code Annotated 16-10-314, for expenses of the
 8 University of Arkansas at Little Rock - William H. Bowen School of Law for
 9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

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 16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
 18 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing
 19 and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director,
 20 assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at the
 21 University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of Trustees may make special
 22 allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may
 23 determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and
 24 exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head
 25 coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of providing such
 26 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary
 27 income of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, which is derived from
 28 athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars
 29 (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each fiscal year for the
 30 athletic director and head coaches, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the
 31 aggregate for such purposes during each fiscal year for the assistant
 32 athletic directors and assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances
 33 shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic director,
 34 assistant athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches, as
 35 established herein provided that the amount of such allowance shall not
 36 exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum for any one salaried

1 position. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are
2 utilized the University of Arkansas at Little Rock shall report annually to
3 the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of those
4 special allowances funds.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
6 ~~2011~~ 2012 through June 30, ~~2012~~ 2013.

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8 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
14 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
30 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
2 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.

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
