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7 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 9 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS. The Legislative Auditor is hereby authorized to direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer appropriation 10 11 between the line items of the appropriation in Section 2 of this Act in such 12 amounts determined necessary. In no event, however, shall the Regular 13 Salaries line item in Section 2 be increased or decreased by such transfers 14 authorized herein, until the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 15 reviews such transfers. 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010

17 18 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

19 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. 21 Employees of the Division of Legislative Audit shall be eligible for cost-of-22 living increases on July 1, in an amount equal to that granted to all other 23 state agency, board, commission or institution of higher education employees 24 on those dates. Any additional adjustments in annual salary rates for 25 Division employees, labor market adjustments, merit pay adjustments or 26 employee retention or recruitment requirements shall be made at the 27 discretion of the Legislative Auditor. In addition, the Legislative Auditor 28 may implement a merit program to reward employees of the Division for 29 exceptional service. The plan shall be approved by the Legislative Joint 30 Auditing Committee prior to its implementation. In order that exceptionally 31 well-qualified personnel may be recruited and retained, the Division of 32 Legislative Audit may exceed the maximum salary levels by no more than twenty 33 percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the positions authorized in 34 the appropriation act after receiving approval from the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee. Salary payments in accordance with this 36 section shall not be restricted to maximum amounts authorized by law.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010 2 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013. 3 4 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDS. 6 In the event the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint 7 Auditing Committee should receive any funds in connection with performing 8 their duties as prescribed by the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, such 9 funds shall be deposited into the State Central Services Fund to be utilized 10 solely by the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing 11 Committee in performing such duties. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 13 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013. 14 15 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 24 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 33 34 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

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Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
2	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
4	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
5	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
