SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 10 DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS. Funding provided in Sections 7 and 8 of this Act from 11 the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund shall not be distributed unless there are 12 sufficient funds in the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund as of the date that the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State certifies the amount in excess of the 13 14 required reimbursement to the counties as provided in §26-26-310(b)(2)(C)(i). 15 If there are sufficient funds remaining in the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund on December 31, 2010 2012, as certified, the Treasurer shall distribute four 16 17 million dollars (\$4,000,000) to counties and four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to cities for the fiscal year ending June 30, $\frac{2011}{2013}$ from the balance 18 remaining on December 31, 2010 2012 from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund. 19 20 The distribution to counties shall be made in accordance with the distribution 21 formula in §19-5-602(c). The distribution to cities shall be made in 22 accordance with the distribution formula in §19-5-601(b). The funds 23 attributable to sales and use taxes levied prior to July 1, 2010 2012 shall 24 not be transferred from the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund to the cities and 25 counties. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 26 27 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013. 28 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 30 31 TURNBACK - UNANTICIPATED FUNDS. The appropriation authorized for General Revenue to Counties in Section 3, or any other appropriation as provided by 32 33 the General Assembly for aid to counties may be supplemented, if necessary, 34 by a transfer from the appropriation provided for Unanticipated Special 35 Revenues in Section 5 of this Act.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010

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1 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

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SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LOANS TO 5 CITIES AND COUNTIES. On July 1 of each fiscal year, the Chief Fiscal Officer 6 of the State shall request a transfer by the State Treasurer from the Budget 7 Stabilization Trust Fund to the County Aid Fund and to the Municipal Aid Fund 8 to assist the various cities and counties in meeting cash flow needs early in 9 the state fiscal year. The transfer shall be a loan to be repaid in equal 10 installments from general revenue distributions each month during the fiscal 11 year for which the loan was made and shall be in addition to any other loans 12 authorized by law for the County Aid and Municipal Aid Funds. The amount of 13 such loan for each fiscal year shall be \$3,517,657 to the Municipal Aid Fund 14 and \$1,906,079 to the County Aid Fund, or so much thereof as may be available in the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund as determined by the Chief Fiscal 15 16 Officer of the State. Upon such transfer being completed, the State 17 Treasurer shall immediately distribute such funds to each of the several 18 municipalities and counties in the same manner as general revenues are 19 distributed. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Chief Fiscal Officer of

21 the State and the State Treasurer shall make every reasonable, and 22 financially sound effort to insure that local governments receive the full 23 amount of the loan authorized herein on July 1 of each year and that the 24 monies authorized for local governments from general revenues be distributed 25 in equal monthly payments. 26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010

27 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

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SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 31 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year any unexpended funds for the 32 County Aid and Municipal Aid line items shall be carried forward and made 33 available for the same purpose for the next fiscal year.

34 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized 35 herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

(1) Prior to June 30, 2012 the Agency shall by written statement

- 1 set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
- 2 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 3 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of
- 4 Budget shall report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried
- 5 forward by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 6 Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board,
- 7 Commission or Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the
- 8 program name or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a
- 9 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;
- 10 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide
- 11 a written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 12 Committee containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with
- 13 a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract,
- 14 purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later
- 15 than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 16 Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative
- 17 Council/Joint Budget Committee; and
- 18 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration
- 19 shall include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget
- 20 manuals and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission
- 21 or Institution.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 23 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

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- 25 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 26 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 28 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 35 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for		
2	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive		
3	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		
4	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or		
5	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative		
6	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
7			
8	SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
9	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits		
10	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of		
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
13	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
14	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm		
15	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
16	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
17	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
18	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.		
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
