8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR DISASTER
9 ASSISTANCE GRANTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
10 AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH
11 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE
12 FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY SECTION 6 OF ACT 1103 OF
13 2011; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
17 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER
18 DISASTER ASSISTANCE SUPPLEMENTAL
19 APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DISASTER ASSISTANCE GRANTS. There is hereby
26 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
27 Officer, to be payable from the Disaster Assistance Fund, for provisions of
28 disaster grants as authorized by the Disaster Relief Act of 1974 and for
29 complying with the Arkansas Emergency Services Act of 1973 (Arkansas Code 12-
30 75-101 et seq.) by the Office of Emergency Services which shall be
31 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 6 of Act
32 1103 of 2011, the following:

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2 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
3 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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12 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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21 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
23 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to
24 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and
25 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential
26 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
27 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
28 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the
29 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
30 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
31 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
32 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
33 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

34 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
35 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
36 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the

1 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
2 overrides the veto.

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
