AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR CREATION AND
INSTALLATION OF ARKANSAS WINE COUNTRY TRAIL
SIGNAGE FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND
TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 2013; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND
TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT - ARKANSAS WINE
COUNTRY TRAIL SIGNAGE CREATION AND
INSTALLATION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2012-
2013 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS WINE COUNTRY TRAIL SIGNAGE. There
is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
Department, to be payable from the State Highway and Transportation
Department Fund, for expenses of the design, fabrication, construction, and
installation of highway, road, and street signs marking the Arkansas Wine
Country Trail, in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated 27-67-224, of the
Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2013, the sum of.....\$76,000.

SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal



1 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State
2 Treasurer and the Auditor of State the sum of seventy-six thousand dollars
3 (\$76,000) or so much thereof as is available from the unobligated balance in
4 the General Improvement Fund to the State Highway and Transportation
5 Department Fund to provide funds for the purposes and appropriation provided
6 in Section 1 of this Act.

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8 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.

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
