34	SECTION 2. SPECI	AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATE	ED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND		
36	TRANSFER. Immediately	upon the effective date of this Ad	ct, and



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1	notwithstanding the provisions of A.C.A. § 18-28-213 (c)(2) regarding the
2	transfer of funds from the Unclaimed Property Proceeds Trust Fund to the
3	general revenues of the state, the Auditor of State shall transfer on his
4	books and those of the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
5	State the sum of one hundred twenty five thousand dollars (\$125,000) or so
6	much thereof as is available from the balance in the Unclaimed Property
7	Proceeds Trust Fund to the Arkansas Water Development Fund to provide funds
8	for the purposes and appropriation provided in Section 1 of this Act.
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10	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RULES AND
12	REGULATIONS. Notwithstanding any other rules, regulations or provision of law
13	to the contrary the appropriations authorized in this Act shall not be
14	restricted by requirements that may be applicable to other programs currently
15	administered. New rules and regulations may be adopted to carry out the
16	intent of the General Assembly regarding the appropriations authorized in

- 17 this Act.
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19 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 20 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 22 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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29 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 30 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 31 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 32 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 33 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 34 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 35 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 36 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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2	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
3	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
4	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
5	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of		
6	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
7	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
8	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm		
9	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
10	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
11	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
12	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.		
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
