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1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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3	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 16 is amended to add an
4	additional subchapter to read as follows:
5	SUBCHAPTER 12 - STATE AGENCY ACTIONS DUE TO A SHORTAGE OR REDUCTION OF
6	FUNDS
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8	25-16-1201. Employment decisions by state agencies due to a shortage
9	or reduction of funds.
10	(a) As used in this section:
11	(1) "Public safety function" includes without limitation service
12	as a firefighter; and
13	(2) "State agency" means:
14	(A) The Arkansas Agriculture Department, including without
15	limitation the Arkansas Forestry Commission;
16	(B) The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality;
17	(C) The Arkansas Public Defender Commission;
18	(D) The Arkansas Public Service Commission;
19	(E) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
20	Department;
21	(F) The Department of Arkansas Heritage;
22	(G) The Department of Career Education, including without
23	limitation Arkansas Rehabilitation Services;
24	(H) The Department of Community Correction;
25	(I) The Department of Correction;
26	(J) The Department of Education;
27	(K) The Department of Finance and Administration;
28	(L) The Department of Health;
29	(M) The Department of Human Services;
30	(N) The Department of Information Systems;
31	(0) The Department of Parks and Tourism;
32	(P) The Department of Workforce Services;
33	(Q) The State Crime Laboratory;
34	(R) The State Department for Social Security
35	Administration Disability Determination;
36	(S) The State Insurance Department;

1	(T) A state-supported institution of higher education; and
2	(U) The Workers' Compensation Commission.
3	(b) If a state agency elects to terminate employees or eliminate
4	employment positions due to a shortage or reduction of funds available to the
5	state agency:
6	(1) At least one-half (1/2) of the terminated employees shall be
7	from management positions that do not interact with the public or provide a
8	public safety function as a primary function of the employment; and
9	(2) At least one-half (1/2) of the eliminated employment
10	positions shall be management positions for which interaction with the public
11	or the provision of a public safety function is not a primary function of the
12	employment.
13	(c) This section does not prohibit a state agency from terminating an
14	employee or eliminating an employment position for reasons other than a
15	shortage or reduction of funds available to the state agency.
