each chamber on March 2, 2012, or at an earlier time as may be agreed upon by 5 the House of Representatives and the Senate; 6 That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, before (b) 7 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days 8 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill; therefore, from March 9 2, 2012, to March 9, 2012, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall be open so that the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives 10 11 and the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, 12 vetoes of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights; (c) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President 13 14 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation: 15 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 16 noon, March 9, 2012, for the purpose of: 17 (A) Considering vetoes; or 18 (B) Correcting errors and oversights; or 19 (2) Adjourn the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Eighth General 20 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, March 9, 2012, if they determine it 21 is not necessary to reconvene; 22 (d) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before 23 12:00 noon, March 9, 2012, the Fiscal Session of the Eighty-Eighth General 24 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date; and 25 (e) That during the Fiscal Session, in addition to the recess provided 26 for in subdivision (b), the: 27 (1) House of Representatives may recess for periods of four (4) 28 consecutive days or longer, by declaration of the Speaker of the House; and 29 (2) Senate may recess for periods of four (4) consecutive days 30 or longer, by declaration of the President Pro Tempore.
