SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

ASSISTANCE PROVISION. The Department of Correction and the Department of

Community Correction may provide services, furnishings, equipment and office

space to assist the Parole Board in fulfilling the purposes for which the

29 Board was created by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 31 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
