SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation, to be payable from the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation - Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the following:

6	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PROGRAMS OF THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL			
7	ACADEMIC FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the			
8	Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and			
9	Transportation, to be payable from the Educational Facilities Partnership			
10	Fund Account, for grants and aid and special programs providing academic			
11	school facility and transportation assistance to the public school districts			
12	by the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic			
13	Facilities and Transportation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the

26	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE			
27	ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.			
28	TRANSFER AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education $-$ Division of			
29	Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of			
30	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas			
31	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to			
32	request necessary appropriation transfers and any other budget related			
33	adjustments necessary only for the appropriations authorized in this Act.			
34	Furthermore, it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Department of			
35	Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation			
36	be able to make use of additional contractual services as necessary and that			

- l transfers between line items and among appropriations are anticipated to
- 2 accomplish those purposes. Provided, however, that the Department of
- 3 Education Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation
- 4 shall be limited to submitting no more than two transfer requests during any
- 5 fiscal year.
- 6 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 7 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- 8 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
- 9 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
- 10 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 11 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 12 has determined that the Department of Education Division of Public School
- 13 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some
- 14 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -
- 15 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing
- 16 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is
- 17 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
- 18 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 19 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
- 20 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
- 21 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
- 22 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
- 23 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 25 <u>2010</u> <u>2012</u> through June 30, <u>2011</u> <u>2013</u>.

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- 27 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
