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- 2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 4 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in
- 5 Section 2 of this Act on June 30, 2010 2013, shall be carried forward and
- 6 made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 7 2011 2014.
- 8 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
- 9 be carried forward under the following conditions:
