NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 SERVICES - COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS - RESTRICTIONS. 7 Department of Human Services shall not contract or pay for community-based 8 residential programs within any municipality to house unrelated persons who 9 have been adjudicated delinquent of an act that would constitute a Class A felony or higher or of a sexual offense or convicted of a Class A felony or 10 11 higher or sexual offense until the following conditions have been met: 12 1. Residents within one thousand (1,000) feet of the proposed location of the facility shall be notified by mail; 13 14 2. A public hearing shall be conducted in the community of the proposed 15 location of the facility by the contract provider at least ten (10) days in 16 advance of the contract's effective date. Notice of the hearing shall be made 17 by mail to each of the residents within 1,000 feet of the proposed location 18 of the facility. The notification requirement shall not apply to already 19 existing facilities at already existing locations. 20 Provided further, upon establishment of such facilities within a 21 particular municipality, the contract provider and the Department shall 22 establish and implement a system to receive and respond to complaints and 23 questions from residents of such municipality. If it has been 12 determined by the Director of the Department of Human Services that the 13 Division of Youth Services cannot continue a contract with a private provider 14 for educational services and deems it necessary to utilize Division staff to 15 provide the required educational services, the Division is authorized, to 16 seek the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and 17 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to utilize the 18 contingent educational services positions contained in this Act and to make 19 the appropriate transfers from the Residential Services Appropriation line 20 item contained in this Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services Matching,

There is hereby established for the Division of Youth Services - Contingent Educational Services Positions for the 2010-2011 2012-2013 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-101), or its successor.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{14}$ through June 30, $\frac{2011}{2013}$.

SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

1	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
3	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
6	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
