The Executive Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission, 26 with prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget 27 Committee, the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and for the 28 reimbursing of documented expenditures designated by law to be made from the 29 transferred special revenue, may transfer funds among the Livestock and 30 Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry 31 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special 32 Revenue Fund, Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund, and the 33 Poultry and Egg Grading Fund or from these funds to the Livestock and Poultry 34 Fund Account. The purpose of these transfers shall only be for accurate 35 allocation of incurred costs between the funds. Requests for fund transfer 36 will at least include the total amount to be transferred, to and from which

funds, the nature, purpose, and time period of the expenditures being
 reimbursed, and any other information requested by the Legislative Council or
 the Joint Budget Committee.

4 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 5 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 6 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 7 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 8 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 9 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 10 has determined that the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and 11 Poultry Commission may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is 12 provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and Poultry 13 Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 14 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 15 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 16 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 17 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 18 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 19 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 20 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
22 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

24 SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 26 PROVISION - PEST ERADICATION. If the State Plant Board determines that the 27 demands of pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses, 28 with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval by 29 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be 30 transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line 31 items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services 32 Matching.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 3 has determined that the State Plant Board may operate more efficiently if 4 some flexibility is provided to the State Plant Board authorizing broad 5 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 6 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 7 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 8 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 9 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 10 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 11 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 12 void.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 14 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

16 SECTION 46. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 18 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is 19 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum 20 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-21 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a 22 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year. 23 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who 24 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five 25 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as 26 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor 27 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen 28 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 30 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

32 SECTION 47. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 34 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary 35 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a 36 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

1 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees

2 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such 3 personnel.

4 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air 5 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and 6 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 7 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be 8 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in Section 3 and 30. 9 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for 10 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is 11 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees 12 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the 13 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation 14 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3 15 and 30.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 17 2010 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

SECTION 48. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to expenditure.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
27 <u>2012</u> through June 30, 2011 2013.

28

SECTION 49. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 31 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. The Secretary of the Arkansas Department of 32 Agriculture shall at no time designate general revenue allocations to the 33 State Plant Board, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission and the Arkansas Forestry Commission at a level less than the revenue distribution 34 35 provided in the Official Forecast of state general revenue in effect for each 36 of those agencies.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
 2012 through June 30, 2011 2013.

4 SECTION 50. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING 6 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall present the following 7 data each month to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas 8 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. This report shall be due by 9 the 10th day of the month following the reporting period. The first reporting 10 period shall be July 2012. 11 All fund transfers completed by the Arkansas Forestry Commission a) 12 from any funding source including federal funds, and shall include 13 a justification for the completion of the fund transfers. 14 All expenditures incurred by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from b) any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a 15 16 justification for the expenditure of the funds. 17 All revenue receipts of the Arkansas Forestry Commission including c) but not limited to federal funds, general revenue, severance tax, 18 19 acreage tax, timber sales and seedlings sales. 20 All Arkansas Forestry Commission activities including but not d) limited to, firefighting activities, fire prevention, and 21 22 emergency response as it relates to the Commission's statutory 23 mission provided in Arkansas Code 15-31-101. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 24 25 2012 through June 30, 2013.

27 SECTION 51. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 52. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 

## SECTION 53. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

- 20 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.

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
