19	DEVELOPMENT OF A LONG-RANGE PLAN TO

26	WHEREAS, in recent years, the state has worked to increase Internet
27	access serving the medical community and institutions of higher education;
28	and
29	WHEREAS, the promise of that improved accessibility to broadband
30	connectivity, broadband capacity, and related Internet technology has not
31	reached many rural communities and public school districts whose economic and
32	educational needs remain underserved; and
33	WHEREAS, research studies have shown that improved accessibility to
34	broadband connectivity, broadband capacity, and related Internet technology
35	benefits rural economic development through increased market access, higher
36	salaries and employment opportunities, and educational improvements; and

1 WHEREAS, research has also shown that improved accessibility to 2 broadband connectivity, broadband capacity, and related Internet technology 3 improves the overall quality of life through more efficient delivery of 4 government services, improved health care, and instant access to information 5 locally, nationally, and globally; and

6 WHEREAS, the State Board of Education will implement Common Core 7 assessments in Arkansas public schools beginning with the 2014-2015 school 8 year, which will be conducted electronically and therefore require increased 9 accessibility to broadband connectivity, broadband capacity, and related 10 Internet technology for Arkansas public schools; and

WHEREAS, public school students will further benefit from the improved
 delivery of twenty-first century educational services using broadband
 connectivity, broadband capacity, and Internet technology; and

WHEREAS, a long-range plan should be developed in collaboration with the private sector to provide improved accessibility to broadband connectivity, broadband capacity, and related Internet technology to improve economic development, education, and quality of life for all Arkansans, 18

19 NOW THEREFORE,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 88TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF 21 ARKANSAS:

23 That the Senate support the collaboration of state and private sectors 24 to:

(1) Identify the needs and priorities of Arkansas communities and
public school districts for improved accessibility to broadband connectivity,
broadband capacity, and related Internet technology; and

28 (2) Develop a long-range plan for addressing those needs by October 1,29 2012.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate encourage the completion of a 32 long-range plan and the presentation of a report on that plan to the 33 Legislative Council and Joint Budget Committee for their consideration in the 34 budget hearings for the 2013 regular session of the 89th General Assembly. 35
