5	(d) The Legislative Council shall review a
6	modification to the reimbursement rate promulgated by the Chief Fiscal
7	Officer of the State.
8	(iii) The reimbursement rate under this subdivision
9	(b)(2)(A) applies to all officers and employees of state government,
10	including without limitation constitutional officers and their employees and
11	state elected officials and their employees.
12	(B) A state agency director may authorize reimbursement
13	for travel expenses for meals, lodging, and private automobile or airplane
14	usage at amounts less than that established under the authority of this
15	section.
16	(C) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State by regulation
17	may establish procedures and the rate for reimbursing individuals for the use
18	of privately owned airplanes while traveling on official business for the
19	state.
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
