21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
22		
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-5-101(9), concerning the definition of	:
24	lump-sum service under the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement	
25	System, is amended to read as follows:	
26	(9) "Lump-sum service" means that, upon termination of	
27	employment with the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department fo	r
28	whatever reason, all lump-sum payments of leave, salary, or other	
29	compensation shall $\underline{\mathtt{not}}$ be $\underline{\mathtt{earnings}}$ for retirement purposes. Both the time a	. nd
30	amount paid shall be considered for purposes of computing average earnings	
31	and <u>time of</u> service <u>in for</u> the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement	
32	System, and both the member's and the employer's contribution rates shall	
33	apply to the lump-sum payments;	
34		
35	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
36	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the	

1	Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System law are in urgent need of
2	revision to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;
3	that this revision is of great importance to citizens of the State of
4	Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary to maintain an orderly
5	system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas State Highway Employees'
6	Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this
7	act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
8	safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
