6	designated area shall receive the funds which that the rural volunteer fire		
7	department or fire protection district would have been eligible to receive.		
8	(B) The funds shall be used by the municipality to provide		
9	training and, to purchase equipment necessary to provide fire protection in		
10	the designated unincorporated area in compliance with this subchapter, to		
11	purchase insurance for buildings, or to pay utility costs.		
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
