15 TO AMEND ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; TO
16 REGULATE THE PROCUREMENT OF PASSENGER
17 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRUCKS; AND TO ALLOW A

19 VEHICLES AND TRUCKS FROM A SOURCE OUTSIDE

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-222(a), concerning the State
27 Procurement Director's exclusive jurisdiction over procurement, is amended to
28 read as follows:

29 (a) The State Procurement Director shall have exclusive jurisdiction
30 over the procurement of:

31 (1) ~~Items~~ Printing, stationery, and supplies subject to Arkansas
32 Constitution, Amendment 54;

33 (2) Wholesale gasoline, oil, and related products;

34 (3) Tires;

35 (4) ~~Passenger motor vehicles and trucks, except highway~~
36 ~~construction and highway maintenance equipment or any specialized type of~~



1 ~~equipment used in highway construction, except as otherwise provided in this~~
 2 ~~subchapter;~~

3 ~~(5)~~ Paper products;

4 ~~(6)~~(5) New and used school buses for state agencies;

5 ~~(7)~~(6) A purchasing card program and travel card program to
 6 include implementation and administration; and

7 ~~(8)~~(7) An electronic commerce procurement solution to include
 8 planning and administration consistent with the established financial systems
 9 of the state.

 11 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-11-223, concerning commodities,
 12 technical and general services, and professional and consultant services
 13 under state contract, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as
 14 follows:

15 (f) If the director awards a state contract for the procurement of
 16 passenger motor vehicles and trucks, a state agency may elect not to
 17 participate in the state contract if the state agency can demonstrate that it
 18 can procure passenger motor vehicles and trucks from another source at the
 19 same price as the passenger motor vehicles and trucks procured under the
 20 state contract.

 22 SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Applicability. This act applies to
 23 procurement under this subchapter on or after the effective date of this act.
 24 This act does not apply to a transaction, event, obligation, or duty arising
 25 out of or associated with procurement under this subchapter before the
 26 effective date of this act.
