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2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas		
4	Teacher Retirement System Act addressing the administration of disability		
5	retirement are in need of revision to maintain the teacher retirement laws i		
6	conformance with sound public pension policy and proper administration; that		
7	the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a July 1 to June 30 fisca		
8	year; and that this act is necessary to allow the provisions impacting		
9	disability retirement to begin on the first day of the fiscal year.		
10	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary		
11	for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
12	effective on July 1, 2013.
