Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of 11 the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the amount and the 12 purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and such appropriation as 13 needed shall be established upon the books of the Department of Finance and 14 Administration and the State Auditor. Provided, however, that in the event 15 the total amount of transfer requested in any fiscal year exceeds Ten 16 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall seek 17 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,—2012 20 2013 through June 30,—2013 2014.

SECTION 73. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION ESTABLISHMENT. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall have the authority to establish such positions as necessary for State agencies to process payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for federal and state tax reporting purposes as necessary to comply with the United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes for personal services. The positions established shall not be considered as part of the total number of authorized positions for an agency and shall only be considered as placeholders for payments to individuals who are board or commission members or elected officials of the State that do not otherwise receive salaries or wages as defined in §19-4-521 for their personal services. Further, none of the positions established under this section

- 1 shall imply eligibility for state retirement or state health insurance
- 2 benefits. The establishment of such positions shall not exceed 250 positions
- 3 in any fiscal year.

- 5 SECTION 74. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
- 6 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 7 AUTHORIZED BURN CENTER. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the
- 8 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed
- 9 \$1,000,000 each fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from
- 10 funds made available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn
- 11 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The
- 12 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental
- 13 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.

- 17 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of
- 18 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of
- 19 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost
- 20 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost
- 21 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for
- 22 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of
- 23 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal
- 24 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development
- 25 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of
- 26 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of
- 27 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation
- 28 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that
- 29 cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information
- 30 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes.
- 31 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the
- 32 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the

- 2 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the

- 5 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from
- 6 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund

- 24 PROCEDURES EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient
- 25 appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help
- 26 for any state agency for the period ending June 30, 2014, said agency may
- 27 request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section 2,
- 28 Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

TRANSFER. On July 1, 2013, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall

transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor

of State the balances of the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Guarantee Fund

to the Firemen's and Police Officers' Pension and Relief Fund.

SECTION 79. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 80. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 81. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

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     effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
