Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of 23 the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the amount and the 24 purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and such appropriation as 25 needed shall be established upon the books of the Department of Finance and 26 Administration and the State Auditor. Provided, however, that in the event 27 the total amount of transfer requested in any fiscal year exceeds Ten 28 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall seek 29 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 30 before the transfer shall be made.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012
2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

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SECTION 73. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION
 ESTABLISHMENT. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall have the authority

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1 to establish such positions as necessary for State agencies to process 2 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for federal and state tax reporting purposes as necessary to comply with the 3 4 United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and 5 Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which 6 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes 7 for personal services. The positions established shall not be considered as 8 part of the total number of authorized positions for an agency and shall only 9 be considered as placeholders for payments to individuals who are board or 10 commission members or elected officials of the State that do not otherwise 11 receive salaries or wages as defined in §19-4-521 for their personal 12 services. Further, none of the positions established under this section 13 shall imply eligibility for state retirement or state health insurance 14 benefits. The establishment of such positions shall not exceed 250 positions 15 in any fiscal year.

17 SECTION 74. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 18 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 19 AUTHORIZED - BURN CENTER. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed 20 21 \$1,000,000 each fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from 22 funds made available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn 23 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The 24 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental 25 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.

SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of 29 30 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of 31 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost 32 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost 33 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for 34 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of 35 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal 36 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development

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1 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of 2 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation 3 4 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that 5 cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information 6 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes. 7 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the 8 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the 9 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the 10 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

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12 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK 14 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the 15 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have 16 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2), such documents 17 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from 18 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund 19 account from which the technical institute or comprehensive lifelong learning 20 center draws its general revenue support. Such funds as may be transferred 21 shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds available from the Work Force 2000 22 Development Fund during each fiscal year.

23 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational 24 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund 25 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and 26 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies 27 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force 28 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational 29 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of 30 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012
2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

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34 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>TRANSFER</u>
 36 PROCEDURES - EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient

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1	appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help
2	for any state agency for the period ending June 30, 2014, said agency may
3	request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section 2,
4	Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
5	stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal
6	Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas
7	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be
8	notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to
9	be made. The appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the
10	Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided
11	further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those
12	regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the
13	agency.

19	TRANSFER. On July 1, 2013, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
20	transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
21	of State the balances of the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Guarantee Fund
22	to the Firemen's and Police Officers' Pension and Relief Fund.

24	SECTION 79. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TENNIS ASSOCIATION GRANTS. There
25	is hereby appropriated to the Department of Finance and Administration -
26	Disbursing Officer, payable from the cash fund deposited in the State
27	Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
28	following:
29	(A) For grants to the Arkansas Tennis Association, for personal
30	services and operating expenses, in a sum not to exceed\$25,000.

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. It is the intent of the General 24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 31 32 SECTION 84. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 33 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of 35

- 36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

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1	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
