29	<u>or</u>			
30	<u>(3) (A)</u>	A beneficiary chosen by the police	officer if before	
31	death the police officer executed a beneficiary form.			
32	<u>(B</u>) The board of trustees shall prov	vide a beneficiary form	
33	to active and retired police officers.			
34	(b) Each board of trustees shall adopt a policy establishing the
