31	<u>(A</u>) If a compounding of the cost of living	ng adjustment is
32	reversed the simple	cost of living adjustment shall be used	for the year that

3	(C) If a compounding cost of living adjustment is
4	reversed, the reversal shall be effective at the beginning of the fiscal
5	year.
6	(4) The compounding cost of living adjustment set by the board
7	shall remain in effect until adjusted or reversed by the board.
8	(5) The board may change the compounding of the cost of living
9	adjustment by resolution at a meeting of the board subject to the limitations
10	under subdivision (b)(6) of this section.
11	(6) The board shall not reverse a compounding cost of living
12	adjustment unless the system's actuary recommends a reversal of a compounding
13	cost of living adjustment to the board in order to address an amortization
14	period in excess of thirty (30) years to pay the unfunded liabilities of the
15	system.
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17	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas
19	Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision to maintain the teacher
20	retirement laws in conformance with sound public pension policy and actuarial
21	appropriateness of the system's plan; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement
22	System operates on a July 1 to June 30 fiscal year; that having a July 1,
23	2013 effective date is necessary to allow the provisions of this act to begin
24	on the first day of the fiscal year and to provide proper administration of
25	the system; and that this act is necessary to maintain an orderly system of
26	benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System.
27	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately
28	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
29	become effective on July 1, 2013.
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
