The Director of the Department of 5 6 Human Services is authorized to use State funds appropriated in this Act to 7 match Federal funds available under Title III and Title V of the Older 8 Americans Act, Social Services Block Grant, or such other federal funds as 9 may become available. 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201211 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014. 12 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND 15 ADULT SERVICES - GRANT/CONTRACT DISBURSEMENT GUIDELINES. All appropriations 16 for state and federal funding contained herein for the Division of Aging and 17 Adult Services and that are distributed under grant or contract methodologies 18 may be disbursed by the Department of Human Services in the same manner as 19 authorized under federal regulations for the disbursement of Title III Older 20 Americans Act funds. Otherwise, all disbursements shall comply with the 21 provisions of this Act. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201223 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014. 24 25 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND 27 ADULT SERVICES - NURSING HOME CARE ALTERNATIVES. Funding for "Nursing Home 28 Care Alternatives", as it appears in the Aging and Adult Services -29 Operations appropriation may be used for home delivered meals, adult day 30 care, homemaker/chore, respite care, personal care, health promotion, and 31 other community-based activities. These funds may also be used to match 32 Medicaid community-based programs. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201234 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENIOR 2 CITIZEN CENTERS. The appropriation in this act for Senior Citizen Centers 3 shall be distributed in the same manner as the funding formula requirements 4 set out in the federal Older Americans Act funding law. The additional 5 funding provided by this provision shall supplement and not supplant any 6 monies currently funding services for Senior Citizen Centers.

7 The requirements in this section shall only be implemented in accordance 8 with any necessary approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services 9 and in the event that additional general revenue funding is provided by the 10 General Assembly for these purposes. Should additional funding provided for 11 these purposes be insufficient to provide for the increases in full, the 12 increases shall be provided to the extent that funding is made available. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2012}{1}$ 14 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

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16 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34

35 <u>SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u>
 36 <u>General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits</u>

1	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
3	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
6	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
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
