## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY  
15 CORRECTION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2013-  
16 2014 FISCAL YEAR.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Department of Community Correction for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

 33 of Community Correction for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following maximum  
 34 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 35 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) temporary  
 36 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those

1 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
 2 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

 4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 5 appropriated, to the Department of Community Correction, to be payable from  
 6 the Department of Community Correction Fund Account, for personal services

 26 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY  
 28 CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of  
 29 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the  
 30 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the  
 31 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of  
 32 Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for "Community  
 33 Correction Program" line item in this Act to construct new or renovate  
 34 existing facilities to support the development of community correction  
 35 facilities in the state.  
 36 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

1 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
2 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
3 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
4 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
5 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
6 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more  
7 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community  
8 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both  
9 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by  
10 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
11 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative  
12 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.  
13 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
14 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,  
15 this entire section is void.

19 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR  
21 VEHICLE PURCHASE PROVISION. The Department of Community Correction is hereby  
22 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for  
23 Capital Outlay in Section 3 and Section 4 in this Act.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
25 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

26  
27 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARKING  
29 FEES. On July 1, of each year the Department of Community Correction shall  
30 pay from the appropriation provided herein from non-general revenue, the  
31 total amount appropriated for War Memorial Stadium Commission Parking  
32 Services from Fees to the War Memorial Stadium Commission.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
34 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

35  
36 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
2 PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer  
3 of the State and review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
4 Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Department of Community  
5 Correction is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item  
6 authorized in Section 3 and Section 4 of this Act to any other line item  
7 authorized in Section 3 and Section 4 of this Act.

8 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
9 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
10 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
11 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
12 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
13 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
14 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more  
15 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community  
16 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both  
17 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by  
18 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
19 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative  
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.  
21 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
22 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,  
23 this entire section is void.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
25 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

26  
27 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
29 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections  
30 that a reallocation of resources within the Department of Community  
31 Correction and Department of Correction is necessary for the efficient and  
32 effective operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the  
33 Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
34 Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the department directors, to  
35 request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions,  
36 programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or



1 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of  
2 the departments. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be  
3 made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary  
4 transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the  
5 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
6 and the Departments of Correction and Community Correction. Provided,  
7 however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than two  
8 requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during any  
9 fiscal year per department. Transfer authority shall further be limited to  
10 no more than five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special  
11 Revenue appropriation, funding, and positions specific to each agency.

12 However, there shall be no transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement  
13 Fund. A Reallocation of Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following  
14 specific purposes:

- 15 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
- 16 b) Payment of Debt Service;
- 17 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
- 18 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
- 19 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
- 20 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
- 21 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
- 22 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the  
23 mission of the agency.

24 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
25 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
26 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
27 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
28 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
29 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
30 has determined that the Department of Correction and the Department of  
31 Community Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is  
32 provided to the Board of Corrections authorizing broad powers under the  
33 Reallocation of Resources provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary  
34 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring  
35 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as  
36 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.  
 2 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
 3 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire  
 4 section is void.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
 6 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

7  
 8 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY  
 10 COMPENSATION. The Department of Community Correction is authorized to pay  
 11 employees for up to ninety-six (96) hours of unused holidays exceeding a  
 12 balance in the employee's holiday account of one-hundred fifty (150) hours  
 13 following the end of the calendar year. Payments of unused holiday hours must  
 14 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating  
 15 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for  
 16 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is  
 17 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the  
 18 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that  
 19 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the  
 20 following classifications:

 35 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL

1 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of  
 2 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a  
 3 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to  
 4 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is  
 5 allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after  
 6 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
 7 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained  
 8 in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and  
 9 Services line item contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries,  
 10 Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance and General Operations  
 11 classifications. Further, the Department may utilize the service(s) of a  
 12 state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment Service, or network,  
 13 as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the occupancy of the  
 14 positions stated herein.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
 16 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

17  
 18 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR

 19 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY  
 21 CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the  
 22 line item established herein for "Community Correction Program" are to be  
 23 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and  
 24 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for  
 25 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community  
 26 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction  
 27 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision,  
 28 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of  
 29 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~  
 31 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

 33 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
 35 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent  
 36 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community

1 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 - State  
2 Operations to Operating Expense Item (04)(A) in Section 3 - State Operations  
3 for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal  
4 Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a  
5 report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
6 Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of  
7 transfer.

8 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
9 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
10 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
11 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
12 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
13 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
14 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more  
15 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community  
16 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is  
17 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight  
18 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
19 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the  
20 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this  
21 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint  
22 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent  
23 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

24  
25 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY  
27 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community  
28 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post  
29 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail  
30 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for  
31 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail  
32 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of  
33 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the  
34 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end  
35 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than  
36 three (3) years.

1  
2 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
3 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11  
12 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

20  
21 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
22 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
23 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of  
25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm  
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
31 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
