110-407." SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-110-407(a), concerning the time period in which to answer in a garnishment proceeding, is amended to read as follows: (a) If any garnishee, after having been duly served with a writ of garnishment, shall neglect or refuse to answer the interrogatories exhibited to him or her, on or before twenty (20) thirty (30) days after service of the writ, the court, upon motion of the plaintiff, may issue a notice to the garnishee, requiring him or her to appear personally at a hearing not later than ten (10) days after receipt of said notice or at such other later date as the court may fix and answer the allegations and interrogatories of the plaintiff. Service of the notice may be made either by the clerk, or by the plaintiff, by any method prescribed by Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure for service of notice.
