## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE LOOKBACK PERIOD ALLOWABLE FOR  
THE SEIZURE OF A PERSON'S MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN HE OR  
SHE IS CONVICTED OF DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, FOURTH  
OFFENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO INCREASE THE LOOKBACK PERIOD ALLOWABLE  
FOR THE SEIZURE OF A PERSON'S MOTOR  
VEHICLE WHEN HE OR SHE IS CONVICTED OF  
DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, FOURTH  
OFFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-117(a)(1)(A), concerning the seizure  
of a motor vehicle for driving while intoxicated, fourth offense, is amended  
to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is found  
guilty of violating § 5-65-103 for a fourth offense occurring within ~~three~~  
~~(3)~~ five (5) years of the first offense, at the discretion of the court, may  
have his or her motor vehicle seized.
