4	to all parties, the court may order that the money deposited in the court, or		
5	any part thereof, be paid immediately to the person or persons entitled

7	(b) If the compensation finally awarded shall exceed exceeds the		
8	amount of money $soledientering$ deposited by ten percent (10%) or more, the court shall		
9	enter judgment against the State of Arkansas and in favor of the parties
