23	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

25	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Ark	ansas Legislative										
26	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passag	e and adoption.

28	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determin	ed by the General										
29	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas pro	hibits the										
30	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period;	that the										
31	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to th	e operation of										
32	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are prov	ided, and that in										
33	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the de	lay in the										
34	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work in	reparable harm										
35	upon the proper administration and provision of essential go	<u>vernmental</u>
