14 AN ACT FOR THE PULASKI TECHNICAL COLLEGE  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL  
16 YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Pulaski Technical College for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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33 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
34 the Pulaski Technical College for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following  
35 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
36 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four

1 hundred (400) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay  
 2 not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation  
 3 Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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 5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 6 appropriated, to the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from the  
 7 Pulaski Technical College Fund, for personal services of the Pulaski  
 8 Technical College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the following:

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 14 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 15 to the Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
 16 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Pulaski Technical College, for personal  
 17 services and operating expenses of the Pulaski Technical College for the  
 18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the following:

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1 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
7 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
8 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
9 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
10 with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
23 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of  
25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm  
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
31 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
