# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1324

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT CONCERNING AN OFFICER WHO DEFAULTS ON  
9 DELIVERING AN EXECUTION; MAKING § 16-66-118  
10 CONSISTENT WITH ACT 1151 OF 2003; EXTENDING THE TIME  
11 PERIOD DURING WHICH EXECUTIONS ARE RETURNABLE; AND  
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 CONCERNING AN OFFICER WHO DEFAULTS ON  
17 DELIVERING AN EXECUTION; EXTENDING THE  
18 TIME PERIOD DURING WHICH EXECUTIONS ARE  
19 RETURNABLE.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. The introductory language of Arkansas Code § 16-66-118(a),  
25 concerning an officer who defaults on delivering an execution, is amended to  
26 make the statute consistent with Act 1151 of 2003 to read as follows:

27 (a) Each officer to whom any execution is delivered shall be liable  
28 and bound to pay the whole amount of money specified in or endorsed on the  
29 execution and directed to be levied if he or she willfully:

31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-66-416(a), concerning the returns of  
32 executions, is amended to read as follows:

33 (a) All executions shall be returnable ~~in sixty (60)~~ within ninety  
34 (90) days from their date.
