21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-9-202 is amended to read as follows:	:

11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 22-9-209(a), concerning contracts for the
12	renovation of historic sites, is amended to read as follows:
13	(a) No \underline{A} contract for the altering, repairing, or renovation of a
14	recognized historic site or structure owned by the State of Arkansas or with
15	title vested in the name of a state agency or of another taxing authority,
16	$\overline{\text{where}}$ $\underline{\text{in which}}$ the estimated cost of the work equals or exceeds the sum of
17	ten thousand dollars ($\$10,000$), twenty thousand dollars ($\$20,000$) shall not
18	be entered into between the <u>state</u> agency <u>or taxing authority</u> and any
19	contractor unless the $\underline{\text{state}}$ agency $\underline{\text{or taxing authority}}$ $\underline{\text{shall have}}$ $\underline{\text{has}}$ first
20	published notice of intention to receive bids for improvements one (1) time
21	each week for not less than two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of
22	general circulation published in the county in which the proposed
23	improvements are to be made or in a trade journal reaching the construction
24	industry.
