8	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE GIVING, BARTERING, OR SELLING
9	OF E-CIGARETTES AND OTHER NICOTINE PRODUCTS TO
10	MINORS; TO PROHIBIT MINORS FROM POSSESSING OR
11	PURCHASING E-CIGARETTES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15	TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSFER OF E-CIGARETTES
16	AND OTHER NICOTINE PRODUCTS TO MINORS;
17	AND TO PROHIBIT MINORS FROM POSSESSING OR
18	BUYING E-CIGARETTES.
19	
20	
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	5-27-233. Providing minors with e-cigarettes and e-cigarette products
24	prohibited Purchase, use, or possession prohibited Self-service
25	displays and vending machines prohibited.
26	(a) As used in this section:
27	(1) "E-cigarette" means an electronic oral device that provides
28	a vapor of nicotine or another substance that, when used or inhaled simulates
29	smoking, including without limitation a device that:
30	(A) Is composed of a heating element, battery, electronic
31	circuit, or a combination of heating element, battery, or electronic circuit;
32	(B) Works in combination with a liquid nicotine delivery
33	device composed either, in whole or in part, of pure nicotine and
34	manufactured for use with e-cigarettes; and
35	(C) Is manufactured, distributed, marketed, or sold as an
36	e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, or under any other product name or descriptor;

1	<u>and</u>
2	(2) "Self-service display or vending machine" means a display or
3	vending machine:
4	(A) That contains e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products;
5	(B) That is located in an area where customers are
6	permitted; and
7	(C) In which e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products are
8	readily accessible to a customer without the assistance of a salesperson.
9	(b)(l) It is unlawful for a person or business to give, barter, or
10	sell to a minor:
11	(A) An e-cigarette; or
12	(B) An e-cigarette product.
13	(2) A business owner who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or
14	is found guilty of violating subdivision (b)(1) of this section is guilty of
15	a violation and is subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100)
16	per violation.
17	(3) An employee of a business who violates subdivision (b)(1) of
18	this section is subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100)
19	per violation.
20	(c)(l) It is unlawful for a minor to:
21	(A) Use or possess or to purchase, or attempt to purchase:
22	(i) An E-cigarette; or
23	(ii) An E-cigarette product; or
24	(B) For the purpose of obtaining or attempting to obtain
25	e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products, falsely represent himself or herself to
26	be eighteen (18) years of age or older by displaying proof of age that is
27	false, fraudulent, or not actually proof of the minor's age.
28	(2) An e-cigarette or e-cigarette product found in the
29	possession of a minor may be confiscated and destroyed by a law enforcement
30	officer.
31	(d) It is not an offense under subsection (c) of this section if the
32	minor was acting as an agent of a business within the scope of employment.
33	(e) A person or business that sells e-cigarettes or e-cigarette
34	products has the right to deny the sale of e-cigarettes or e-cigarette
35	products to any person.
36	(f) It is unlawful for a business to fail to display in a conspicuous

1	place or on each vending machine a sign indicating that the sale of e-
2	cigarettes or e-cigarette products to or purchase or possession of e-
3	cigarettes or e-cigarette products by a minor is prohibited by law.
4	(g) It is unlawful for a manufacturer to distribute a free sample of
5	an e-cigarette or e-cigarette product or a coupon that entitles the holder of
6	the coupon to a free sample of an e-cigarette or e-cigarette product:
7	(1) In or on a public street or sidewalk within five hundred
8	feet (500') of a playground, public school, or other facility when the
9	playground, public school, or other facility is being used primarily by
10	minors for recreational, educational, or other purposes; or
11	(2) To a minor.
12	(h)(1) It is unlawful for a person or business to sell or distribute
13	e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products through a self-service display or
14	vending machine that is accessible to minors.
15	(i) A court shall consider the following factors when reviewing a
16	possible violation of this section:
17	(1) The business has adopted and enforced a written policy
18	against selling e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products to minors;
19	(2) The business has informed its employees of the applicable
20	laws regarding the sale of e-cigarettes or e-cigarette products to minors;
21	(3) The business has required employees to verify the age of an
22	e-cigarette or e-cigarette products customer by way of photographic
23	identification;
24	(4) The business has established and imposed disciplinary
25	sanctions for noncompliance; and
26	(5) That the appearance of the purchaser of the e-cigarettes or
27	e-cigarette products was such that an ordinary prudent person would believe
28	him or her to be of legal age to make the purchase.
