Arkansas Code § 12-15-201, concerning definitions related 19 to concealed handgun permits, is amended to add new definitions to read as 20 follows: (3) "Auxiliary law enforcement officer" means a person certified 21 22 by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training and 23 approved by the county sheriff or chief of police of a municipality where he 24 or she is acting as an auxiliary law enforcement officer if: 25 (A) The auxiliary law enforcement officer has completed 26 the minimum training requirements and is certified as an auxiliary law 27 enforcement officer in accordance with the commission; and 28 (B) The chief of police of the law enforcement agency or 29 county sheriff authorizes the status of the auxiliary law enforcement officer 30 and the authorization is: 31 (i) In writing; 32 (ii) In the possession of the auxiliary law

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8	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202(a) and (b), concerning the		
9	eligibility to carry a concealed handgun for law enforcement officers, are		
10	amended to read as follows:		
11	(a) Any certified law enforcement officer or auxiliary law enforcement		
12	officer acting as an auxiliary law enforcement officer may carry a concealed		
13	handgun if that officer is:		
14	(1) Presently Is presently in the employ of a public law		
15	enforcement department, office, or agency;		
16	(2) Authorized Is authorized by the public law enforcement		
17	department, office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of		
18	his or her duties;		
19	(3) Not Is not subject to any disciplinary action that suspends		
20	his or her authority as a law enforcement officer by the public law		
21	enforcement department, office, or agency;		
22	(4) Carrying Is carrying a badge and appropriate written		
23	photographic identification issued by the public law enforcement department,		
24	office, or agency identifying him or her as a certified law enforcement		
25	officer; and		
26	(5) Not Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law+;		
27	(6) Is not under the influence of alcohol or another		
28	intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance; and		
29	(7) Has fingerprint impressions on file with the Department of		
30	Arkansas State Police Automated Fingerprint Identification System.		
31	(b)(l) A concealed handgun may be carried by any retired law		
32	enforcement officer or retired auxiliary law enforcement officer acting as a		
33	retired auxiliary law enforcement officer who:		
34	(A) Retired <u>in good standing</u> from service with a public		
35	law enforcement department, office, or agency for reasons other than mental		
36	disability;		

1	(B) Immediately before retirement was a certified law		
2	enforcement officer authorized by a public law enforcement department,		
3	office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her		
4	duties;		
5	(C) Is carrying appropriate written photographic		
6	identification issued by a public law enforcement department, office, or		
7	agency identifying him or her as a retired and former certified law		
8	enforcement officer;		
9	(D) Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law <u>from</u>		
10	receiving or possessing a firearm;		
11	(E) Has fingerprint impressions on file with the		
12	Department of Arkansas State Police <u>Automated Fingerprint Identification</u>		
13	System together with written authorization for state and national level		
14	criminal history record screening; and		
15	(F) During the most recent twelve-month period has met, at		
16	the expense of the retired law enforcement officer, the standards of this		
17	state for training and qualification for active law enforcement officers to		
18	carry firearms- <u>;</u>		
19	(G) Before his or her retirement, worked or was employed		
20	as a law enforcement officer or acted as an auxiliary law enforcement office		
21	for an aggregate of ten (10) years or more; and		
22	(H) Is not under the influence of alcohol or another		
23	intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance.		
24	(2)(A) The chief law enforcement officer of the city or county		
25	shall keep a record of all retired law enforcement officers authorized to		
26	carry a concealed handgun in his or her jurisdiction and shall revoke any		
27	authorization for good cause shown.		
28	(B) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State		
29	Police shall keep a record of all retired department officers authorized to		
30	carry a concealed handgun in the state and shall revoke any authorization for		
31	good cause shown.		
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
