24	investigators hired by the Criminal Investigation Division of the State		
25	Insurance Department, is amended to read as follows:		
26	(a)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ The Criminal Investigation Division is established within		
27	the State Insurance Department.		
28	(B) The State Insurance Department is designated as a law		
29	enforcement agency.		
30	(2)(A) The Insurance Commissioner shall appoint the full-time		
31	supervisory and investigative personnel of the division, who shall be		
32	qualified by training and experience to perform the duties of their		
33	positions.		
34	(B) A person designated and employed as an investigator		
35	for the division shall:		
36	(i) Be a certified law enforcement officer under §		

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1	12-9-101 et seq.; and		
2	(ii) Have statewide law enforcement jurisdiction and		
3	authority.		
4	(3)(A) The commissioner shall designate the personnel assigned to the		
5	division, who, upon meeting the qualifications established by the Arkansas		
6	Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, shall have the powers		
7	of specialized law enforcement officers of the State of Arkansas for the		
8	purpose of conducting conduct investigations under § 23-66-504 and any		
9	criminal violations related to those investigations.		
10	(B) Personnel hired as specialized law enforcement officers		
11	shall have a minimum of three (3) years of certified law enforcement		
12	experience or its equivalent in national or military law enforcement		
13	experience as approved by the commission.		
14	(4) The commissioner shall also appoint clerical and other staff		
15	necessary for the division to carry out its duties and responsibilities under		
16	this subchapter.		
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
