3	related thereto, and any other insurance fraud matters as may be assigned at		
4	the discretion of the director.		
5	(ii) The Insurance Commissioner shall designate the		
6	personnel assigned to the unit, who, upon meeting the qualifications		
7	established by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and		
8	Training, shall have the powers of specialized law enforcement officers of		
9	the State of Arkansas for the purpose of conducting conduct investigations		
10	under this subdivision (d)(1)(B).		
11	(iii) A person designated and employed as an		
12	investigator by the Workers' Compensation Fraud Investigation Unit of the		
13	State Insurance Department shall:		
14	(a) Be a certified law enforcement officer		
15	under § 12-9-101 et seq.; and		
16	(b) Have statewide law enforcement		
17	jurisdiction and authority.

27	(a)(1) The Criminal Investigation Division is established within the		
28	State Insurance Department and is designated a law enforcement agency.		
29	(2)(A) The Insurance Commissioner shall appoint the full-time		
30	supervisory and investigative personnel of the division, who shall be		
31	qualified by training and experience to perform the duties of their		
32	positions.		
33	(B) A person designated and employed as an investigator		
34	for the division shall:		
35	(i) Be a certified law enforcement officer under §		
36	12-9-101 et seq.; and		

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(ii) Have statewide law enforcement jurisdiction and

2	authority.
3	(3)(A) The commissioner shall designate the personnel assigned to the
4	division, who, upon meeting the qualifications established by the Arkansas
5	Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, shall have the powers
6	of specialized law enforcement officers of the State of Arkansas for the
7	purpose of conducting conduct investigations under § 23-66-504 and any
8	criminal violations related to those investigations.
9	(B) Personnel hired as specialized law enforcement officers
10	shall <del>have a minimum of three (3) years of</del> <u>be state</u> certified in law
11	enforcement <del>experience</del> or <del>its</del> <u>the</u> equivalent in national or military law
12	enforcement experience as approved by the commission.
13	(4) The commissioner shall also appoint clerical and other staff
14	necessary for the division to carry out its duties and responsibilities under
15	this subchapter.
