2	shall collect the fee and remit the fee monthly to the Director of the		
3	Department of Finance and Administration, except that. However, if the sale		
4	occurs through a livestock auction market or any other agent of the seller,		
5	the livestock auction market or other agent shall collect and remit the fee.
