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5-69-218. Pipelines and pipeline facilities.

13 (a) A person who knowingly violates 49 U.S.C. § 60114(b), § 60118(a), or § 60128 as they existed on February, 2013, or a regulation prescribed or 14 15 order issued under 49 U.S.C. § 60101 et seq. shall be fined under United 16 States Code Title 18 or imprisoned for not more than five (5) years, or both. 17 (b) A person who knowingly damages or destroys an interstate gas 18 pipeline facility, an interstate hazardous liquid pipeline facility, or 19 either an intrastate gas pipeline facility or intrastate hazardous liquid 20 pipeline facility that is used in interstate or foreign commerce or in any 21 activity affecting interstate or foreign commerce, or who attempts or 22 conspires to do such an act, shall be fined under United States Code Title 18 23 or imprisoned for not more than twenty (20) years, or both, and if death 24 results to any person, shall be imprisoned for any term of years or life. 25 (c) A person who knowingly defaces, damages, removes, or destroys a pipeline sign or right-of-way marker required by law or regulation of the 26 27 United States shall be fined under United States Code Title 18 or imprisoned for not more than one (1) year, or both. 28 29 30 31

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
