Arkansas Code § 14-271-109(a), concerning notice to One 7 Call Center and exceptions under the Arkansas Underground Facilities Damage 8 Prevention Act, is amended to read as follows: 9 (a) Compliance with notice requirements of § 14-271-112 is not 10 required for: 11 The moving of earth that is not on a right-of-way or within (1) 12 an easement of an operator by tools manipulated only by human or animal 13 power; 14 (2) Any <u>agricultural purposes, including any</u> form of cultivation 15 for agricultural purposes, digging for postholes on private property, 16 construction and maintenance of farm ponds, land clearing, or other normal 17 agricultural purposes which, that are not on a right-of-way of an operator; 18 (3) Work by a public agency or its contractors on a 19 preengineered project; 20 (4)(3) The opening of a grave in a cemetery that is not on a 21 right-of-way of an operator; or 22 (5)(4) Routine road work and general maintenance as performed in 23 the right-of-way by state or county maintenance departments, but excluding 24 any work or maintenance involving change of grade or elearing or widening 25 drainage ditches any demolition or excavation. 26 27 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 271, Subchapter 1, is 28 amended to add an additional section to read as follows: 29 14-271-116. Criminal penalties. 30 (a) A person shall be fined under Title 18 of the United States Code, imprisoned for not more than five (5) years, or both, if the person: 31 32 (1) Knowingly and willfully engages in an excavation or 33 demolition activity: 34 (A) Without first notifying the One Call Center as 35 required by this chapter to establish the location of underground facilities 36 in the excavation or demolition area; or

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1	(B) Without heeding the appropriate location information		
2	required by this chapter or any markings the operator of a pipeline facility		
3	establishes; and		
4	(2) Subsequently damages:		
5	(A) A pipeline facility, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 60101,		
6	as in effect on February 1, 2013, that results in death, serious bodily harm,		
7	or actual damage of more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); or		
8	(B) A pipeline facility, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 60101,		
9	as in effect on February 1, 2013, and knows or has reason to know of the		
10	damage, but does not report the damage promptly to the operator of the		
11	pipeline facility and to other appropriate authorities.		
12	(b) Penalties under this section may be reduced in the case of a		
13	violation that is promptly reported by the violator.		
14	(c) This section does not apply to the following persons or entities		
15	or their officers or employees:		
16	(1) The State Highway Commission;		
17	(2) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department;		
18	(3) County judges; or		
19	(4) County road departments.		
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
