- 16 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 14-271-109(a), concerning notice to One
- 17 Call Center and exceptions under the Arkansas Underground Facilities Damage
- 18 Prevention Act, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) Compliance with notice requirements of § 14-271-112 is not
- 20 required for:
- 21 (1) The moving of earth that is not on a right-of-way or within
- 22 an easement of an operator by tools manipulated only by human or animal
- 23 power;
- 24 (2) The moving of earth by an operator that is on a right-of-way
- 25 <u>or within an easement of the operator by tools only manipulated by human</u>
- 26 power and exclusively for the purposes of system maintenance and leak
- 27 detection;
- 28 $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ Any agricultural purposes, including any form of
- 29 cultivation for agricultural purposes, digging for postholes on private
- 30 property, construction and maintenance of farm ponds, land clearing, or other
- 31 normal agricultural purposes which, that are not on a right-of-way of an
- 32 operator;
- 33 (3) Work by a public agency or its contractors on a
- 34 preengineered project;
- 35 (4) The opening of a grave in a cemetery that is not on a right-
- 36 <u>of-way of an operator</u>; or

2	the right-of-way by state or county maintenance departments, but excluding

6	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 271, Subchapter 1, is		
7	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
8	14-271-116. Criminal penalties.		
9	(a) A person shall be fined under Title 18 of the United States Code,		
10	imprisoned for not more than five (5) years, or both, if the person:		
11	(1) Knowingly and willfully engages in an excavation or		
12	demolition activity:		
13	(A) Without first notifying the One Call Center as		
14	required by this chapter to establish the location of underground facilities		
15	in the excavation or demolition area; or		
16	(B) Without heeding the appropriate location information		
17	required by this chapter or any markings the operator of a pipeline facility		
18	establishes; and		
19	(2) Subsequently damages:		
20	(A) A pipeline facility, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 60101,		
21	as in effect on February 1, 2013, that results in death, serious bodily harm,		
22	or actual damage of more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); or		
23	(B) A pipeline facility, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 60101,		
24	as in effect on February 1, 2013, and knows or has reason to know of the		
25	damage, but does not report the damage promptly to the operator of the		
26	pipeline facility and to other appropriate authorities.		
27	(b) Penalties under this section may be reduced in the case of a		
28	violation that is promptly reported by the violator.		
29	(c) This section does not apply to the following persons or entities		
30	or their officers or employees:		
31	(1) The State Highway Commission;		
32	(2) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department;		
33	(3) County judges; or		
34	(4) County road departments.
